

Михаил Игоревич ВАСИЛЕВСКИЙ

Mikhail Vasilevskiy was graduated from N.I. Lobachevsky University in Gorkii, USSR, in 1981 and received his PhD in Physics and Mathematics from the same University in 1985. He also completed a Habilitation in Physics at the University of Minho (Portugal) in 2004.

Mikhail Vasilevskiy worked as an Associate Professor of Physics in the N.I. Lobachevsky University

and as a Researcher at the Institute for Physics of Microstructures, Russian Academy of Sciences. He also was a post-doctorate researcher at Essex University, UK, and a visiting professor at the *Universidade Federal Fluminense* and the City University of Hong Kong.

Since 1999 Mikhail Vasilevskiy is a professor of Physics at the School of Sciences of Minho University in Portugal (Full Professor since 2006) and a researcher of its Centre of Physics where he also served as Director (2007-08 and 2011-13). His scientific interests are focused on the Physics of Semiconductor Nanostructures, in particular, quantum dots and graphene (theory and modelling of the optical and electronic properties). He authored or co-authored one book, several book chapters and over 150 papers published in peer-reviewed journals.

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
